Question 3

Find something named after a strong pull below the surface; THERE IS AN ART WORK TERMED UNDERCURRENT UNDER THE BRIDGE OVER THE END OF THE ESTURY OUTLET AT THE END OF LAKE MERRITT it is for you to discover under a bridge. Read about it there, on-location, and tell us the name of the Wookie. IF YOU READ THE WRITEUP ON THE SCULPTURE YOU WILL FIND THE NAME OF BRENT THE WOOKIE

Question 4

Head to where those who go commando beneath pleated garments might perform their rituals. Once there, underwear might perform their rituals. **GO TO THE SCOTTISH**

THE DUCK'S EYES LOOK BACK TO THE BOX OFFICE WHICH CONTAINS TWO OLD SAFES.



Question 6

THE STORE I MAGNIN WAS LOCATED AT 2001 BROADWAY IF YOU GO TO THE BACK SIDE YOU WILL SEE A MURAL OF LILLIES PAINTED USING A MALACHITE GREEN count how many windows are completely within a lily? ONLY ONE WINDOW IS COMPLETEL'Y WITHIN A LILY.

Question 8

A Study in Scarlett A BOOK FROM THE SHERLOCK HOLMES SERIES could have been purchased at this former Oakland specialty store whose name was also the sir name of the works' most famous protagonist. HOLMES BOOKSTORE STOOD ON 14TH BETWEEN ALICE AND HARRISON Once you arrive at the spot where it once stood in all its 1920s glory look around. ONCE AT THE HENRY J KAISER CONVENTION CENTER AT 10 10TH STREET YOU WILL FIND A SERIES OF CARVED NIECHES IN THE FAÇADE ONE OF WHICH FEATURES A HORNED GODDESS What two beings flank her? A LIONESS AND A BULL FLANK HER.

Question 10

Down the street from a factory where mechanical beings once growled out purls THERE IS A CLOSED KINTTING FACTORY ON WEBSTER and across from an organization whose aim is to put a 'Stop' to all superfluity STOP WASTE AT 1537 WEBSTER find a dressed up head ACROSS THE STREET IS A LARGE MURAL IN RED AND BLACK OF THE HEAD OF A NATIVE AMERICAN MAN IN A FEATHERED HEADDRESS. Question 11

Oakland resident Huie Kim said 'I came to America for gold as many of my cousins had done before me, ... but I found riches that never rust and a fortune that cannot be stolen.' He served in this brick building built in 1927 and located on a street whose



number is often doubled in China for 'double joy' or 'double happiness'. **EIGHT IS** OFTEN DOUBLED FOR JOY OR LUCK IN CHINA. THE BUILDING IS 265 8TH **STREET** The adjoining building is also brick and was once the home of what Tool and Trade business. PACIFIC TOOL AND TRADE IS NEXT DOOR.

Question 13

Find the house which shares its name with an often-wed Albion King. HENRY HOUSE ON 9TH BETTWEEN BORADWAY AND WASHINGTON Isadora Duncan lived here, giving dancing lessons to neighborhood children, before she moved to Paris. Look for where a berry MARION BERRY and a blossom ROSE work together, MARION AND ROSE AT 461 9TH and turn into a nearby courtyard. WHEN YOU TURN INTO THE COURTYARD AND FOLLOW IT THROUGH YOU GET TO THE BACKSIDE OF THE TRAPPIST AND THEIR OUTDOOR SEATING ENCLOSURE OR COMPOUND Find the compound heralded by the numbers two, two zeros and a seven. THERE IS A SIGN AS YOU ENTER THE BACK DOOR OF THE TRAPPIST THAT FEATURES A CROWN AND 2007 - THE YEAR THE TRAPPIST OPENED Look for what the king might have worn. What image lies beneath it? AN OAK TREE IS UNDERNEATH

Question 14

On the street which shares its number with a pirate's favorite pieces, PIECES OF **EIGHT** find a place of contemplation. Its name includes the basic unit of currency in the destination of silk road YUAN (OR YUN - SINCE IT CAN BE WRITTEN BOTH WAYS IN ENGLISH).
